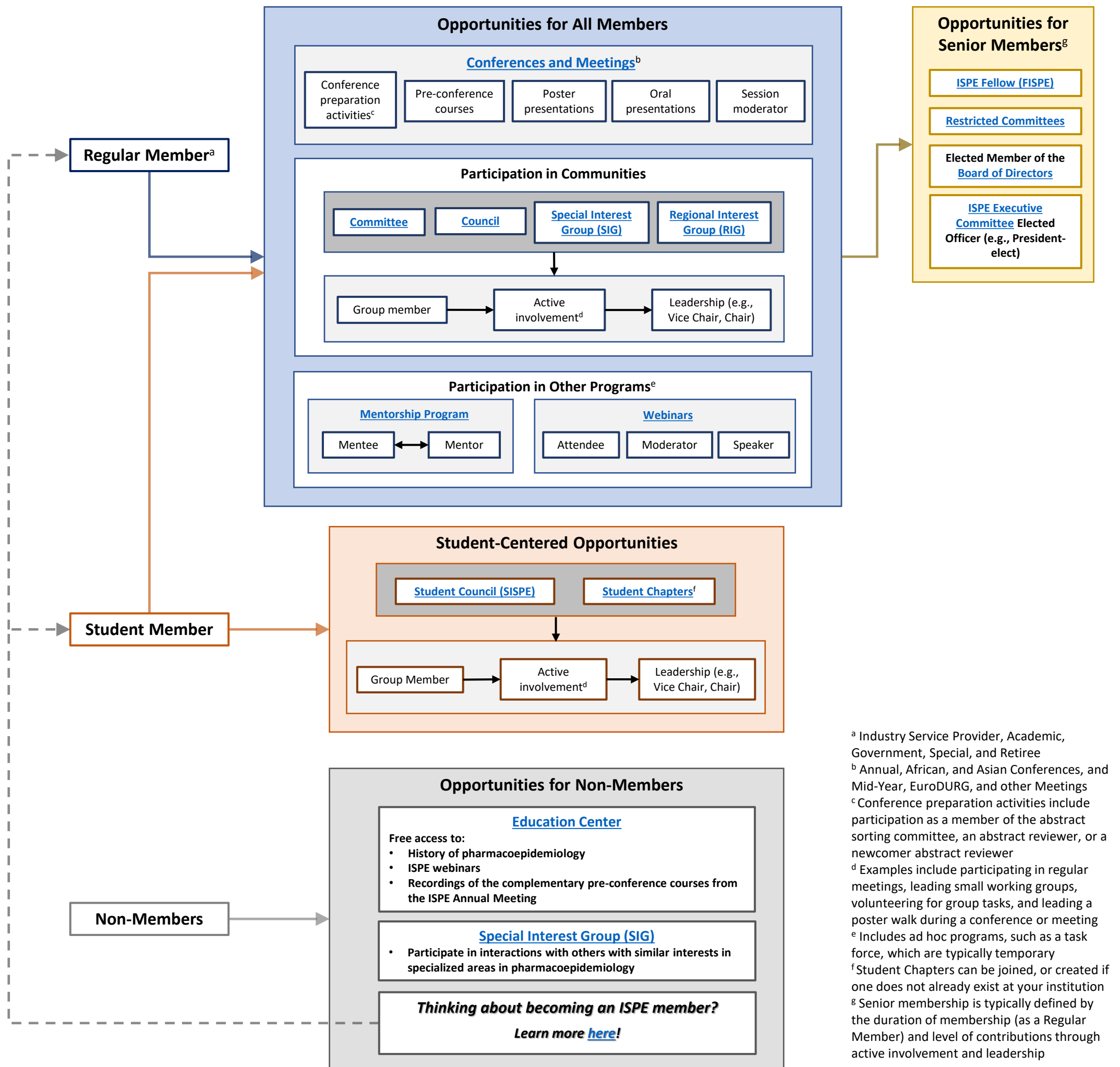


# ISPE Opportunity Pathways: How to get the most out of your ISPE membership
